General Information

- Address and proximity to your assigned facility
- Monthly rent and what it includes
- Lease flexibility (month-to-month, 13-week option)
- Landlord contact details and responsiveness

Bedroom & Sleep Environment

- Quality mattress (memory foam, medium-firm)
- Blackout curtains or blinds
- Noise insulation
- Extra bedding and pillows

Connectivity & Technology

- High-speed Wi-Fi (100 Mbps minimum recommended)
- Wi-Fi speed test results
- Access to virtual training or charting platforms

Laundry & Hygiene

- In-unit washer and dryer
- Cleanliness of unit
- Access to laundry supplies or services

Kitchen & Cooking

- Full kitchen with fridge, oven, and microwave
- Basic cookware, dishes, and utensils
- Dishwasher (bonus)
- Coffee maker and kettle

Safety & Security

Travel Nurse Housing Checklist

- Keyless entry or smart locks
- Well-lit exterior and entryway
- Smoke and CO detectors
- Emergency contact info nearby

Bonus Features (Optional but Nice)

- Private entry
- Workspace or desk
- Outdoor space (balcony, patio)
- Pet-friendly options
- Free or covered parking
